ROAD SAFETY AT THE BEGINNING & END OF THE DAY

Just a reminder about what our 'School Streets' status means, so that we can keep each other safe. In recent weeks we have had two near misses, due both to pedestrian inattention and unauthorised driving on Scarborough Road.

- Scarborough Road is closed to traffic, including parents, at the beginning and end of the school day.
- The only exceptions to this are permit holders, who either live or work on Scarborough Road.
- This means that on occasion, vehicles may enter the School Street zone while children are arriving at or leaving school, so they should remain vigilant.
- Parents, however, should not drive down Scarborough Road around drop off and pick up times.
- As part of the School Streets scheme, we have an agreed Park & Stride scheme, meaning that you can park at Waitrose and walk to school from there.
