ROAD SAFETY

Astrid Copeland & Nikki Michelsberg, two of our Y5 parents, are leading a campaign to improve crossing facilities for pedestrians from Inglewood/ West Chevin Road, which Westgate fully supports. We recently had two meetings about the issue. Firstly, Astrid met Cllr Colin Campbell and Andrew Richardson from Leeds Highways department, and then last week Astrid and I met Cllr Ryk Downes, to discuss the difficulties for pedestrians attempting to cross using the refuge at the bottom of West Chevin Road. It seems that the safest option would be to install a second

pedestrian crossing between the two roundabouts on Bradford Road. We asked about traffic calming measures at the bottom of West Chevin Road, but were told this would not be a preferred option due to night time noise disturbance for residents. In addition, it seems that a request for a 20mph limit on Bradford Road near school is unlikely to succeed due to the fact it is a main road and a bus route.

Astrid is collecting signatures on a petition about the issue and all are welcome to sign it. A copy of the petition is in the school office if you would like to add your signature. You can also email pedestrianwestchevin@outlook.com with concerns, reports of any near misses. All your responses will be collated and passed on to elected members and the highways department. Alternatively, you can make your views known directly to our elected Leeds City councillors. Their contact details can be found here, under our ward (Otley & Yeadon). I would urge anyone with an opinion on this issue to get in touch with Astrid, Nikki or our councillors, to bring about change.

twice-weekly testing for adults with no symptoms. They should not be used on children and are not a substitute for a full PCR test if an adult becomes symptomatic.
