Last half term saw a lot of children taking part in PE and Sport activities both in school and externally - here is a quick summary!



A group of Year 5 and 6 cyclists had a super day out at Leeds Urban Bike Park having a go on BMX bikes, even trying out ramps and jumps!

Mrs Pollhammer is working really hard to develop Netball at Westgate and we are really pleased to see both our Beginner and Advanced after-school clubs flourishing. The Westgate Netball Team played 2 matches against other schools last half term - and won both! A huge WELL DONE to Mrs Pollhammer and the team. Girls AND boys are welcome in the Netball clubs and team, so please get in touch if your child would like to get involved.

Year 4 learned how to play Netball in their PE lessons last half term in preparation for a Netball festival at PHGS; they took part in mini-matches against other local schools and Mrs Hopkins was really pleased with their attitude as well as their ability.

As part of our commitment to Active Travel, we organised scooter training for Year 3 and 5. Year 3 learned how to use their scooter safely on their playground and developed their confidence with turning, braking and being aware of their surroundings, whilst Year 5 went out of school to learn how to navigate pavements, roads and driveways safely. Sticking with the Active Travel theme, Year 6 had a week of Bikeability cycle training, learning how to control their bicycle confidently and, for the more confident cyclists, how to cycle safely on the road. We hope that will encourage more of you to leave the car at home and cycle or scoot to school!


