# CHRISTMAS, COVID-19 AND BEYOND...



I am sure, like me, you all watched the Prime Minister's briefing on Saturday with trepidation. While he made no mention of schools in the briefing, I received guidance from the DfE on Sunday which linked to the measures being taken in response to the Omicron variant. Schools have been directed to ensure that all staff wear masks/ face coverings in any communal areas and when moving around school. As you may be aware, this is a measure we were already implementing at Westgate, in common with many other schools. We are also limiting assemblies to virtual only, the only exception being singing rehearsals for our Christmas events.

On the subject of Christmas events, you will be able to view the Early Years and Key Stage 1 children's performances in the last week of term on our unlisted YouTube channel but they will be removed at the end of term. If you would like to pre-order a DVD to have a more permanent memento beyond this term you can do so on Pay360 from the end of this week. The deadline for orders is Friday 10/12/2021. Any profits from DVD sales will go to School Fund to pay for items related to performances e.g. costumes, props etc. The Key Stage 2 carol service will be available via the church's own live stream in the same way as you were able to view Harvest Festival.

We are once again asking you to limit Christmas cards in school and would suggest that if your child wants to send a card this year, they write one to the whole class which the teacher will open and display for everyone. This limits items being passed between children, as well as saving paper- and time!

Christmas Dinner Day is on 15/12/2021- children may wear a Christmas jumper on this day for a £1 donation to our school charity, Martin House. Children who usually have a packed lunch but would like a school meal on this day should have ordered this already. Then the last day of term is Christmas Party Day- children may come in non-uniform on this day. Instead of party food, we will be accepting donations to Otley Food Bank on this day. We're even hoping that Santa may visit us on this day, if we are really good!
